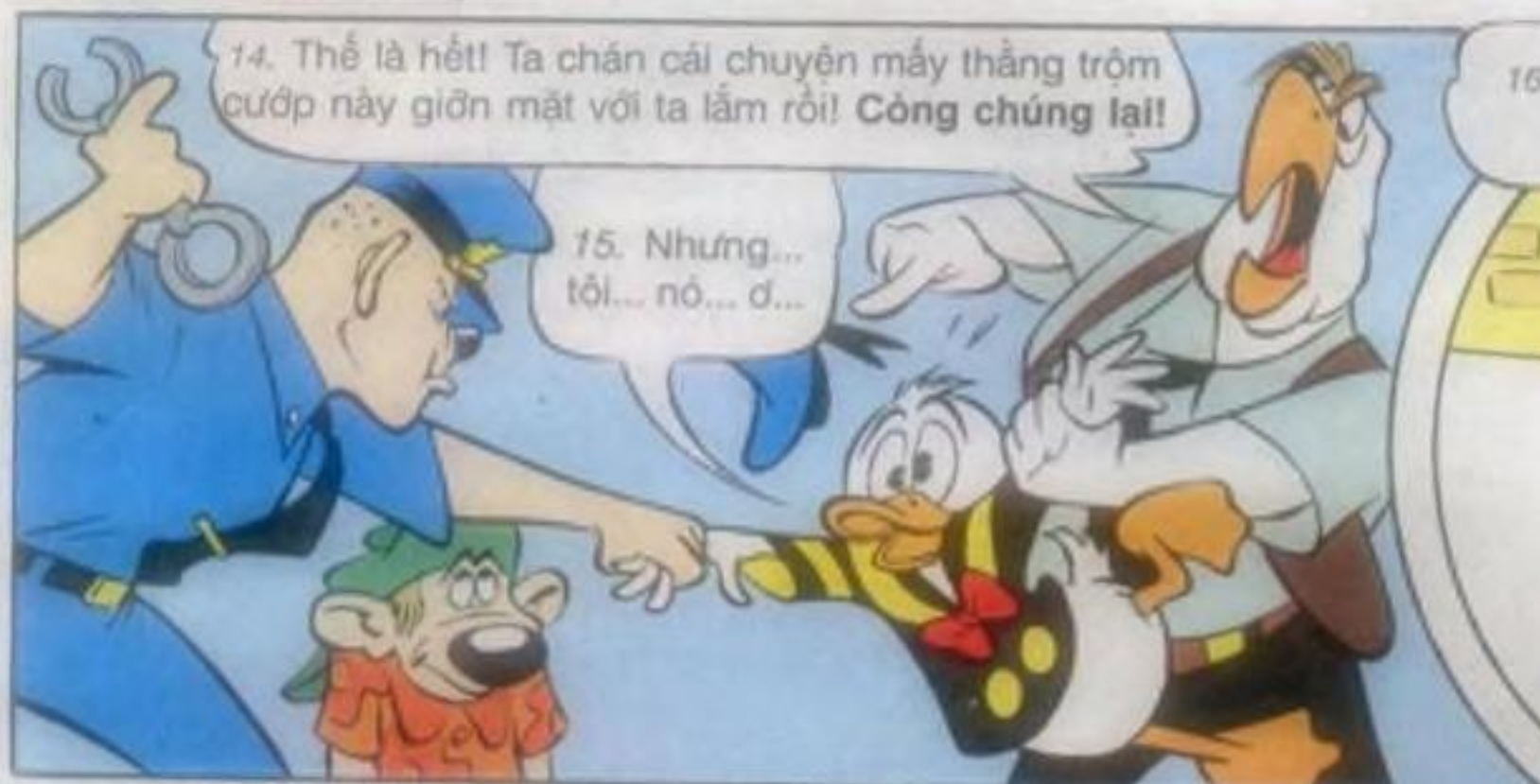

to track!

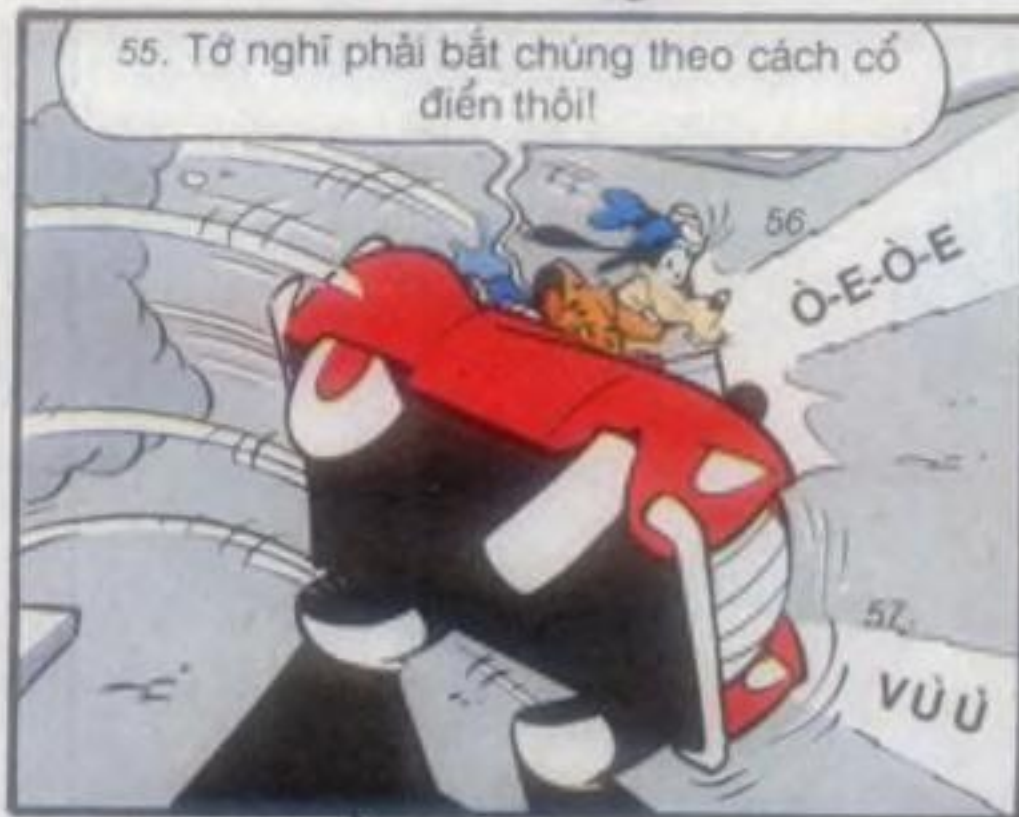
45. It works! We'll stay well back and let them lead us to their hideout!

84. Halp!

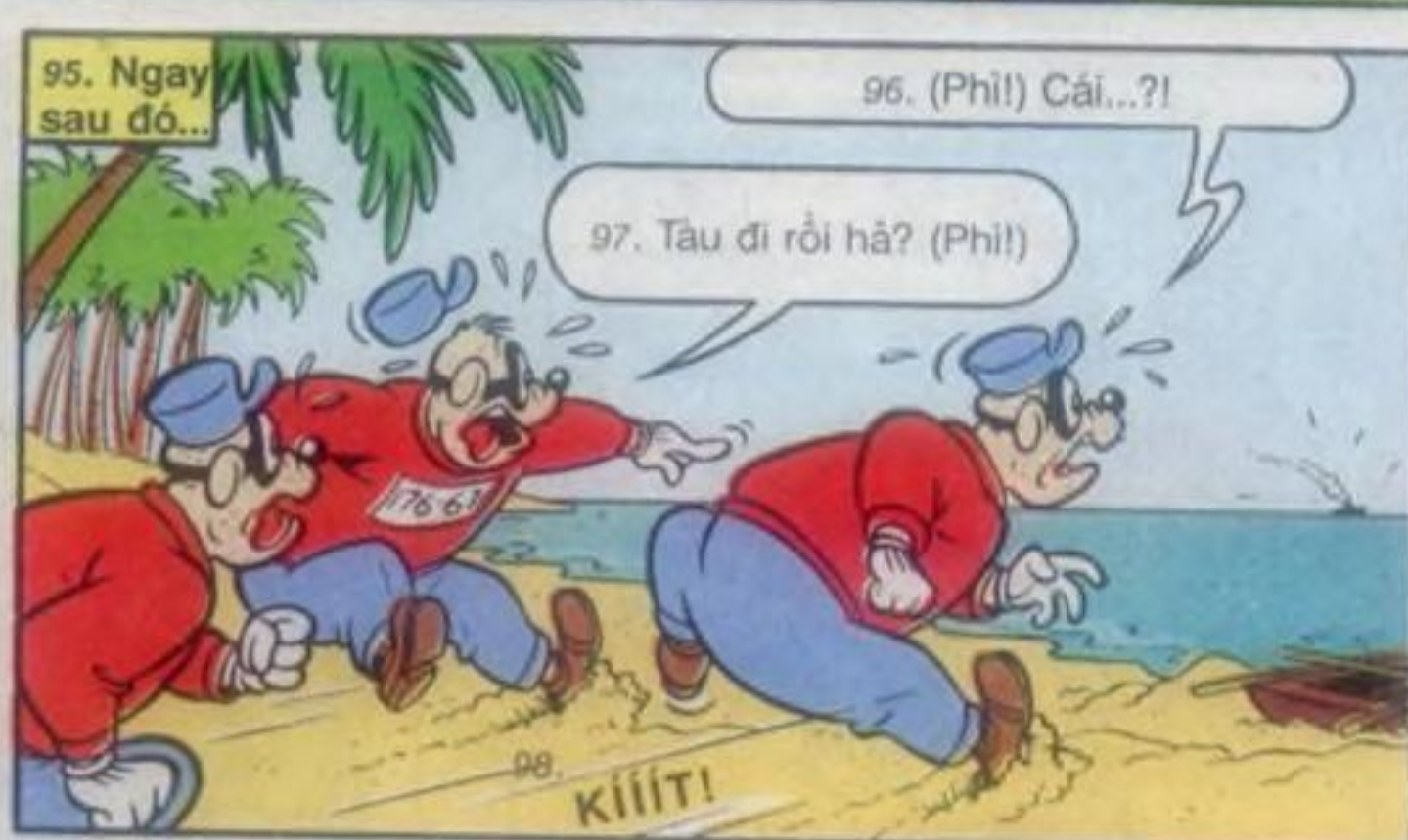
85. I know the story, gentlemen! The statue was stolen from the island of Rorotoro in the South Seas by some pirates 200 years ago!

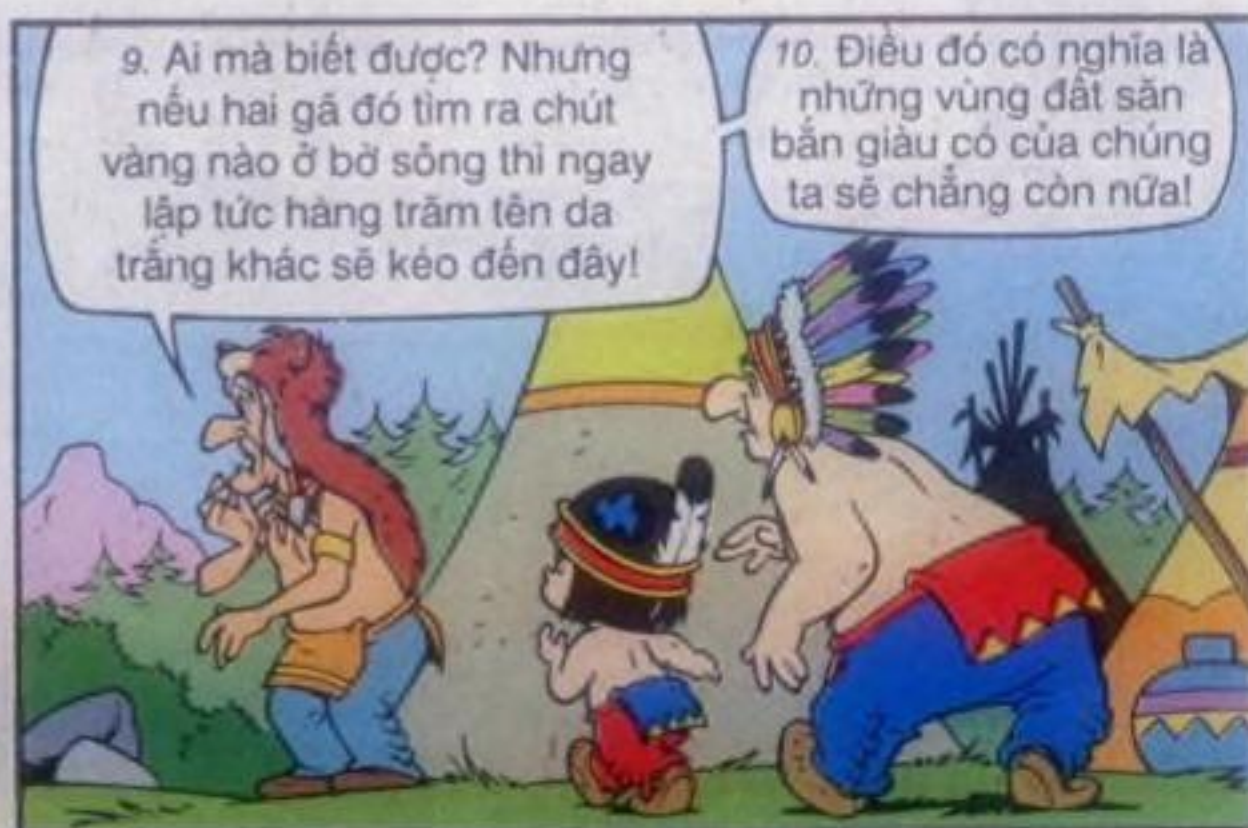

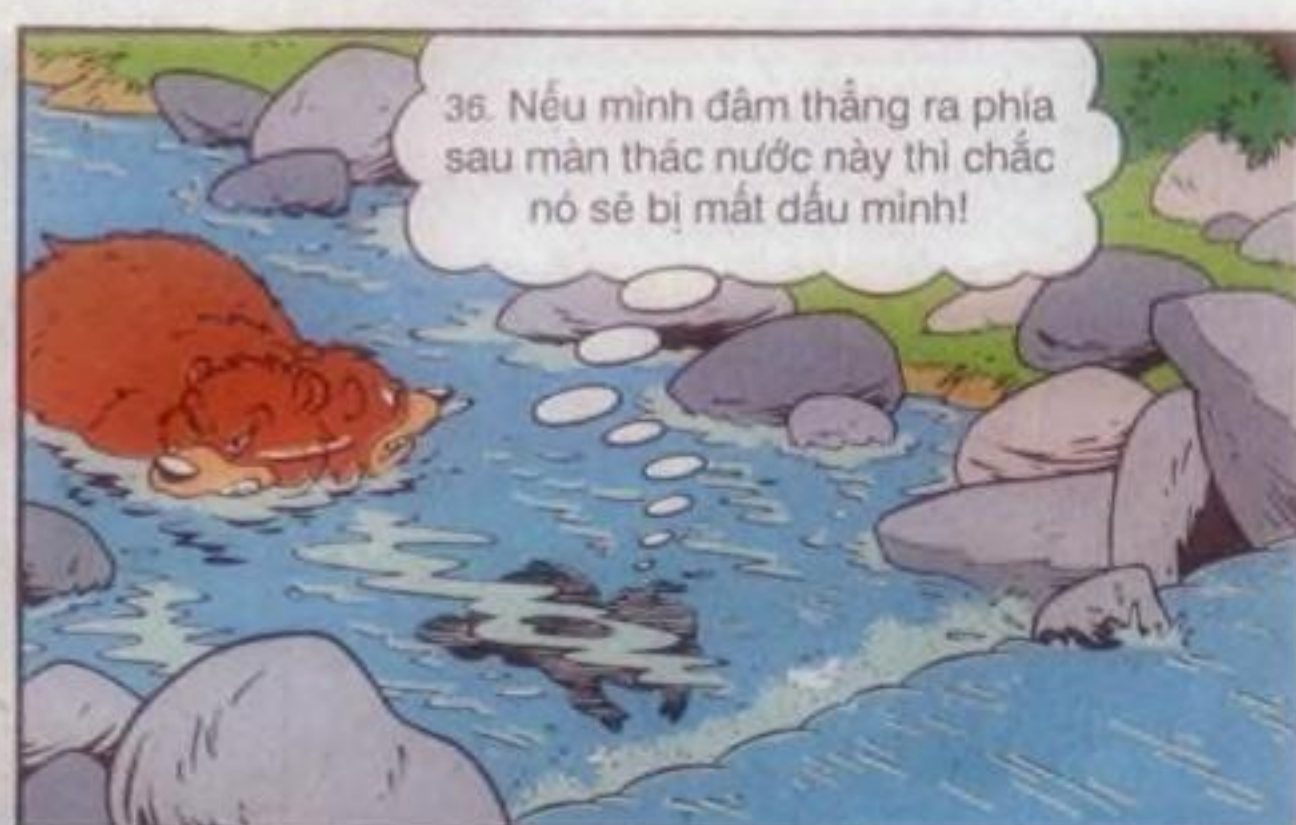
